## **Effect of Noto Peninsula Earthquake in 2024 at Toyama Factory (3<sup>rd</sup> report)**

We, Nissan Chemical Corporation, would like to express our sincere condolences and sympathy toward those who affected by Noto Peninsula Earthquake on January 1, 2024, and also to pray for the earliest restoration in disaster-stricken areas.

As reported on January 16 at our web page as the second report, the operation of ammonia production facility at our Toyama Factory (635, Sasakura, Fuchu-machi, Toyama) was suspended. As of today, it is announced that we have already restarted the operation as described below.

### **1. Production of Ammonia**

Due to the minor and partial damage of the ammonia production facility, its operation was suspended on January 5. Now it is announced that the production has resumed.

### **2. Productions of Urea, Nitric Acid, and other ammonia derivatives**

Following the restart of ammonia production, other facilities related to ammonia would be resumed in a sequential order.

### **3. Financial Impact**

There is minimal effect estimated to the current financial period.
